

Bike bottle holder including bottle

en Installation instructions

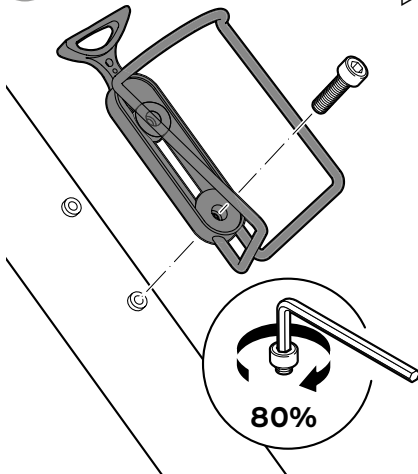
You will need:



Attaching the bottle holder / inserting the bottle

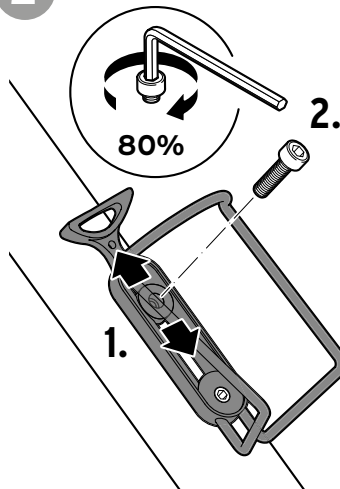
▷ If the threaded holes in your bike frame are sealed with screws or rivets, remove them before mounting the bottle holder.

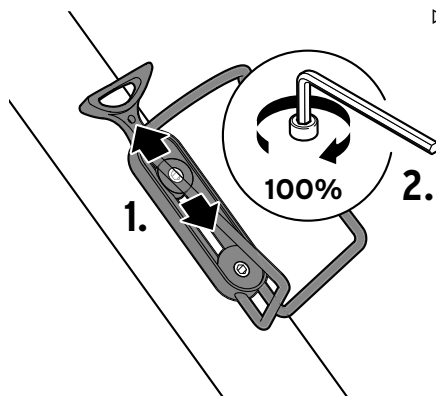
▷ First fasten the bracket at the lower end by carefully screwing one of the two screws supplied through the **fixed** ring into the lower threaded hole. Do not tighten the screw completely yet (approx. 80 %).

1. If necessary, slide the **movable** ring to match the position to the threaded holes in your bike frame.
2. Now carefully insert the second screw through the **movable** ring into the upper threaded hole and start to screw it in. Do not tighten the screw completely yet (approx. 80 %).

▷ Align the bracket once more before tightening both screws completely (100 %).

For your safety, please observe the following instructions ...

... regarding the bottle holder:

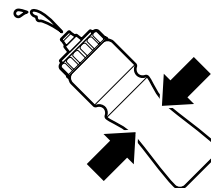
- Keep small swallowable parts (e.g. screws) and packaging materials out of the reach of children. They pose several risks, including the risk of suffocation!
- Carefully remove all packaging material and dispose of it separately. Make sure that you do not inadvertently throw away any assembly materials.
- Threaded holes are required in the bicycle frame to mount the bottle holder.
- The bottle holder is suitable for drinking bottles with a diameter of approx. 7.0-7.2 cm and a capacity of approx. 0.5-0.75 litres.
- Caution! Do not use the bottle holder to carry glass drinking bottles! Danger of cutting injuries if glass breaks during an accident.
- Check that the product is firmly in place before each ride.
- You must continue to pay attention to traffic if you remove the bottle while riding.

... regarding the drinking bottle:

- The bottle supplied has a diameter of approx. 7.2 cm and a capacity of approx. 0.75 litres.
- Only fill the drinking bottle with liquids that are suitable for consumption.
- Do not fill the bottle with any hot beverages! The drinking bottle does not have an insulating function. Risk of burns!
- Do not fill the bottle with liquids that are fermenting, carbonated drinks, milk, alcoholic or caustic liquids.
- Only fill the bottle up to 2 cm below the rim.
- Protect the filled bottle from direct sunlight, extreme overheating and temperatures below 0 °C. Do not place the bottle in the freezer and do not heat the bottle in the microwave.
- Do not keep drinks in the bottle for longer than one day.
- When it is not in use, keep the empty drinking bottle open (without the screw cap in place) to prevent mould.

▷ Clean the bottle and the cap prior to first use and after every further use with warm water, a little washing-up liquid and a soft brush. Allow all the parts to dry thoroughly afterwards.

▷ The opening in the cap is fitted with a valve. Squeeze the bottle to drink.

▷ Push the bottle into the holder from above as far as it will go.
