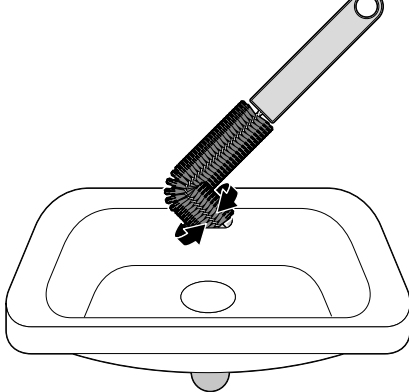


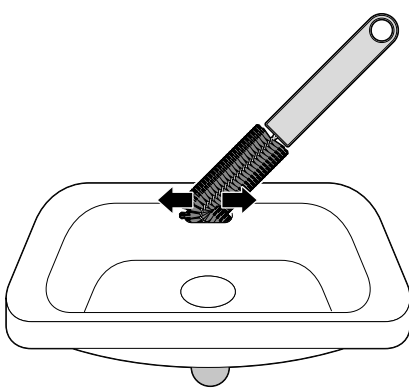

Cleaning the overflow

Depending on the washbasin or sink, the shape and design of the overflow hole may vary. Carefully try the brush to find out how far and at what angle you can insert the brush into the overflow to ensure that it does not get stuck or jammed.



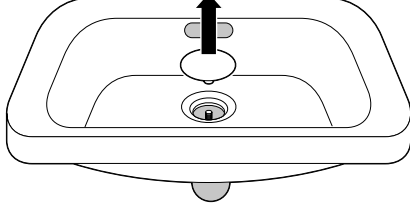
Clean the overflow in a circular motion ...



... and back and forth.

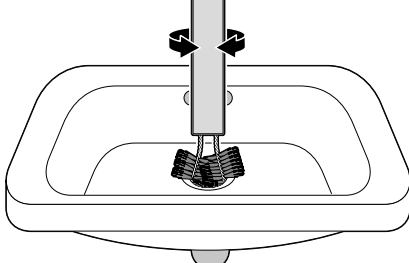
Cleaning the drain opening

1.



Remove the plug.

2.

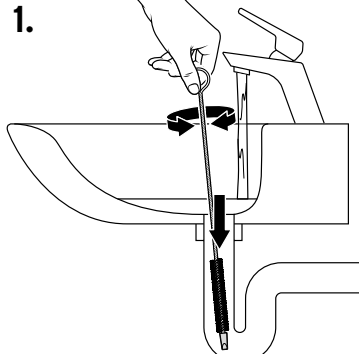


Clean the drain in a circular motion. How far you can insert the brush into the drain opening depends on the shape of the opening.

Cleaning the drainpipe

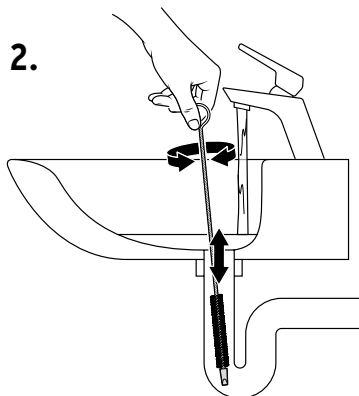
Tip: Open the tap and run warm water while you push the pipe cleaning brush into the drainpipe. When the water is running, it is also easier to pull the brush out of the drainpipe again if it gets stuck.

1.



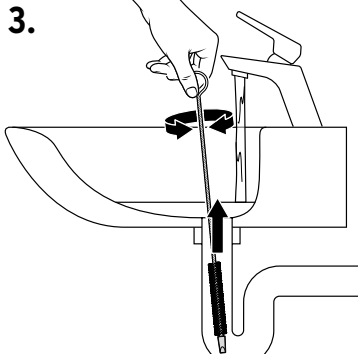
Slowly push the pipe cleaning brush into the drainpipe. In doing so, twist it back and forth, ...

... move the brush up and down while twisting it.

3.



Then slowly pull the brush out of the drainpipe again, while still twisting it.

Then clean the brushes under warm running water. Let the brushes dry completely before storing them.
