


Warning! Safety warnings

Intended use

- The product is suitable for capturing digital photos and video seguences.
- The product is intended for private use and is not suitable for commercial nurnoses. Use the product only in moderate climatic conditions.



Respect the privacy of others!

- · Not suitable for children under 36 months, Small parts, Choking hazard
- Remove all packaging materials before giving the product to a child. Choking hazard.

Danger due to electricity

- Do not immerse the product in water or any other liquids.
- Do not use the device in damp or wet environments
- · Do not use the product if it shows visible signs of damage.
- Do not make any modifications to the product. Do not forcefully open the casing. Only have repairs to the product carried out by a specialist workshop or as arranged by our customer care service. Improper repairs may result in considerable risks to the user

When charging the product, note the following:

- · Rechargeable batteries must only be charged under adult supervision.
- Use only suitable mains adapters (see "Technical specifications"). The product cannot be charged with a USB-C PD mains adapter, for example,
- · Do not use or attempt to repair faulty mains adapters.

- · Only connect the mains adapter to a properly installed wall socket with a mains voltage that complies with the technical specifications of the device. The product must not be connected to the mains power in damp areas.
- · Disconnect the mains adapter from the wall socket: if disturbances occur during use, after use, during thunderstorms and before cleaning the device. To disconnect the mains adapter from the socket, always pull the mains adapter itself, not the connection cable.
- Do not put any receptacles containing liquid, such as vases, on top of or within close proximity of the product. as the receptacle may tip over and the liquid may compromise electrical safety. There is a risk of electric shock.

Danger of explosion/fire/burns

Material damage

- · Taking the product from a cold place to a warm place may cause condensation to form inside. In this case leave the device switched off for a few hours
- · Do not drop the product or subject it to other forms of severe physical
- · Never open or remove any part of the casing. Do not insert any objects into the openings in the casing.
- Protect the product from intense heat (direct sunlight, heaters, etc.) as well as from dust and moisture.
- · When inserting or removing the memory card, ensure that the camera, your hands and the memory card are completely dry.
- · Before cleaning the camera. disconnect it from the computer.
- Do not use any caustic, aggressive or abrasive products for cleaning.

Caution - loss of data

- · Never disconnect the camera from the computer when data is being read, written or deleted. This can result in the loss of data. First disconnect the camera from the computer before switching it off or removing the memory card.
- Do not expose the camera or memory cards to magnets or magnetic fields. A magnetic field can damage or completely erase stored data. It may also cause permanent damage to the storage media. Damage to the camera and repairs performed by customer service or others may also result in an unavoidable loss of data.

• The camera and memory card may feel warm after prolonged continuous use. This is perfectly normal and does not constitute a malfunction.

Note the following when printing:

· When printing at medium or high resolution, allow a short pause between prints to prevent the camera from overheating.

When you connect the camera to the power supply, it will switch on. During charging, the charging indicator light will light up red. Depending on the selected mode, the charging battery icon appears on the display. Once the battery is fully charged, the indicator light turns off.

4. Disconnect the cable from the mains adapter and the camera. Close the cover

Information on rechargeable batteries

- · Charge the rechargeable battery as soon as a low charge level is indicated. If the rechargeable battery is completely flat and the camera can no longer be switched on, allow it to charge for a minimum of 30 minutes.
- To preserve the full capacity of the rechargeable batteries for as long as possible, you should fully recharge the batteries every 2 to 3 months. even if you do not use the product.
- Charge the batteries in an environment between +10 and +40 °C.
- · The batteries will best hold their charge at room temperature. The lower the surrounding temperature, the shorter the playback time.

If you connect the product to a PC for charging, take all the usual precautions regarding backing up your data.



Inserting the microSD card

To store your photos and videos, you can use the camera with a microSD card (not included).


- 1. Turn off the camera and, if necessary, disconnect it from the power supply.
- 2. Open the cover above the USB-C port and the microSD card slot.
- 3. Insert the card into the slot as shown until it clicks into place. You can only insert the card in one orientation. If the card doesn't slide in easily, do not force it - check the orientation.
- 4. Close the cover.
- > Gently press the card to release it it will then spring out. Remove it completely.





formatted in the camera. Three folders are created: VIDEO, PHOTO and MP3. The camera saves captured files in the Video and Photo folders. You can add MP3 files to the MP3 folder from your computer to play music using the camera.

Note the following: Without a microSD card. you cannot record videos. and photos can only be printed directly.



To print your photos directly, insert one of the paper rolls. 1. Fold down the paper tray cover.

Insert printer paper

- 2. Insert the paper roll. Pay attention to the orientation: Unroll the roll from the top as shown.
- 3. Pull the beginning of the paper slightly out of the camera.
- 4. Press down the paper tray cover so that the paper is clamped between the cover and the serrated edge of the paper tray.
- 5. Pull the paper taut.




Attaching the carrying strap

You can attach the included carrying strap to the camera. The wrist strap can easily be detached



Switching on and off



Off - Press and hold until a melody sounds. The display switches off and the operation indicator light goes out.

After approximately 3 minutes without any button being pressed, the camera enters standby mode. The display turns off, but the operation indicator light

To reactivate the camera, briefly press (1).

After a further 2 minutes, the camera switches off completely.

Navigating the menu

- Use the arrow keys to navigate between the individual menu items

If multiple menu items are visible, the currently selected item pulses.
