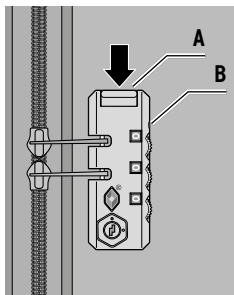


Setting the lock's digit combination

The combination of the lock is factory set to 000. Please proceed as described below to change the combination to a different number:



1. Set the combination to the factory default number. To test it, check whether the opener **A** can be pushed in the direction of the arrow. While setting the new combination leave the zip pullers outside the lock.
2. Using a pen or similar implement, press the adjustment button **B** fully in until it clicks into place.
3. Set the new combination.
4. Press the opener **A** hard. The adjustment button returns to its original position. Your new combination has been set. Check whether it works properly: You must now be able to press the zip pullers into the lock. If you now rearrange the numbers, the opener can no longer be pushed in. The lock is activated.

▷ To set a different combination at a later time, repeat steps 1 to 4 starting from the last selected number combination.

Check that the TSA lock is working properly before closing your suitcase. Note down your chosen combination and store it in a safe place! The manufacturer accepts no liability for incorrect use of the combination lock.

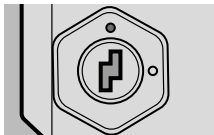
The key to this TSA lock is available to customs officers only. Therefore, no key is enclosed with this product. If customs officers need to open the case, they can do so immediately without damaging the lock.



The logo on your lock indicates to security staff that they can open the lock without using force.

Warning: If the lock has been opened by customs officers and not relocked, you cannot relock it **with any tool**. The matching key is only available to customs officers. If you nevertheless attempt to do so, the lock will be destroyed and can no longer be used.
