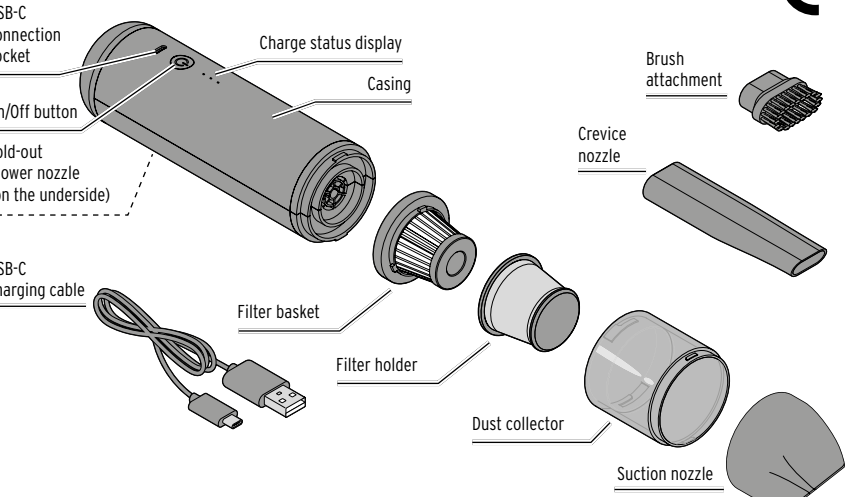


Cordless Vacuum Cleaner

Instructions for use



Safety warnings

This product is equipped with safety features. Nevertheless, read the safety warnings carefully and only use the product as described in these instructions to avoid accidental injury or damage.

Keep these instructions for future reference. If you give this product to another person, remember to also include these instructions.

Intended use

- The cordless vacuum cleaner is designed for vacuuming up dust, dirt and crumbs on smaller surfaces such as in cars, on desks, in PC keyboards, etc. It is not intended for cleaning larger areas or for extended use.
- The product is intended for private use and is not suitable for commercial purposes.

Danger to children and to people with limited ability to operate appliances

- This appliance may be used by children aged 8 and over, and by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capacities or a lack of sufficient experience and/or knowledge, provided they are supervised or have been trained in the safe use of the appliance and understand the potential dangers. Cleaning of the appliance must not be carried out by children without supervision. Children must not be allowed to play with the appliance.
- Keep single-use/rechargeable batteries and the product out of the reach of children.
- Keep the packaging materials out of the reach of children. They pose several risks, including the risk of suffocation!

Danger due to electricity

- Never immerse the appliance or the USB-C charging cable in water or other liquids as this poses a risk of electric shock. Do not touch the appliance with wet hands.
 - Do not insert any pins or other metal objects into the openings on the appliance.
 - Do not use the appliance if the appliance itself or the USB-C charging cable show any visible signs of damage or if the appliance has fallen down.
 - Do not disassemble the appliance any more than instructed in these instructions. Do not make any modifications to the product. Have repairs to the product or USB-C charging cable carried out only by a specialist workshop.
- When charging the cordless vacuum cleaner, note the following:

- Do not put any containers filled with liquid, such as vases, on or within close proximity of the appliance. They could topple over and the liquid could impair the electrical safety of the appliance. There is a risk of an electric shock.
- To charge the appliance, use only suitable USB mains adapters that comply with the "Technical specifications".
- Do not use and do not attempt to repair a faulty USB mains adapter.

Warning – hazards resulting from misuse

Never vacuum up the following:

- glowing ash, cigarette butts, matchsticks, etc.: risk of fire!
- toner for printers: risk of fire/explosion!

- caustic or toxic substances (e.g. acid, asbestos or asbestos dust, etc.): danger to health!
- liquids (in particular liquid carpet cleaners): danger of short circuit!
- pointed, hard objects (splinters of glass, nails, etc.): these can destroy the filter.
- plaster, cement, dust from drilling, construction waste, makeup, etc.: these substances can block the filter and thus damage the appliance.
- cables, wiring, etc.: the insulation could be damaged.
- Do not use the appliance in the vicinity of highly flammable materials.
- Do not use the appliance to vacuum up small objects.

Danger of burns/fire

- You cannot and must not attempt to remove or replace the built-in rechargeable battery yourself. There is a risk of explosion if the battery is replaced incorrectly. It should be replaced only with an identical battery or the same type of battery. If the rechargeable battery is faulty, contact a specialist workshop.
- The product contains a rechargeable lithium-ion battery. This battery must not be taken apart, thrown into fire or short-circuited.
- Do not modify and/or deform/heat/dismantle rechargeable batteries.
- Single-use/rechargeable batteries must not be forcibly discharged.

Danger – risk of injury

- When using the cordless vacuum cleaner in the car: Do not leave the appliance lying around in the car when not in use. It could fly uncontrollably through the inside of the car during extreme driving manoeuvres. Secure the appliance, e.g. in the boot, or keep it at home.
- Make sure that nobody trips over the USB-C charging cable when charging the appliance.
- Never use the vacuum cleaner on people or animals. Always keep hair, parts of the body and items of clothing such as shoe laces and scarves away from the suction opening. Never attempt to remove a blockage when the vacuum cleaner is in operation.
- The appliance must not be connected to the power source via the USB-C charging cable during use, cleaning and when removing the dust collector.

Material damage

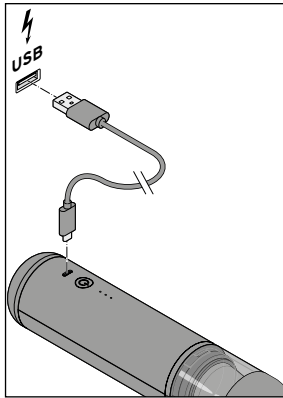
- Do not overheat the cordless vacuum cleaner. Switch it off after max. 12 minutes and leave it to cool down for approx. 30 minutes.
- Ensure that the ventilation slits on the appliance are not covered by dust or similar substances.
- Avoid storing, charging and using the vacuum cleaner at extreme temperatures and extremely low air pressure (e.g. at high altitudes).
- Only ever carry the vacuum cleaner by the handpiece itself, not by the blower nozzle.
- The vacuum cleaner may only be used when fully assembled and with the filter inserted.
- Only use original accessories.
- Protect the appliance from impacts, falls, dust, moisture, direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Protect the rechargeable battery in particular from excessive heat.
- Do not use any caustic, aggressive or abrasive products for cleaning the appliance.

Charging the battery

- ▷ Remove all packaging materials prior to first use.
- The battery is not fully charged upon delivery. To reach the battery's maximum charging capacity, charge the appliance fully before using it for the first time.



1. Connect the cordless vacuum cleaner to a USB mains adapter (not included) using the USB-C charging cable provided.
2. Plug the USB mains adapter into a power socket.

- During the charging process, the indicator lights on the charging status display show the current capacity of the vacuum cleaner:

The indicator light is lit up continuously - fully charged
The indicator light is flashing - charging

The indicator light is out - not yet fully charged
The vacuum cleaner is fully charged when all three indicator lights light up continuously.

The charging time is approx. 3 hours.
The operating time with a fully charged battery is:

- at normal suction approx. 25 minutes.
- at high suction approx. 14 minutes.

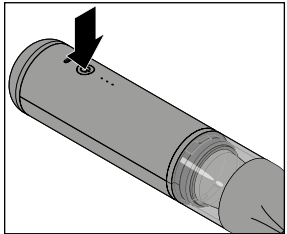
3. After charging, disconnect both the USB mains adapter from the power socket and the USB-C charging cable from the vacuum cleaner.

- To preserve the total capacity of the battery for as long as possible, charge the battery fully every 2-3 months, even if the appliance is not in use.
- Charge the battery in an environment between +10 and +40 °C.
- The battery will hold its charge for the longest at room temperature. The lower the ambient temperature, the shorter the operating time.

Use

- The vacuum cleaner becomes warm during use. This is normal and is not a fault.

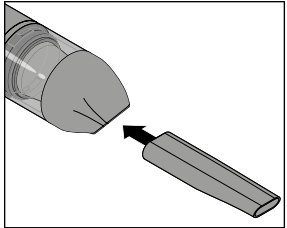
Switching on/off / Increasing suction power



- ▷ Press the On/Off button ...
- ... 1x to switch the vacuum cleaner on.
- ... 2x to increase the suction power.
- ... 3x to switch the vacuum cleaner off.

Using the crevice nozzle

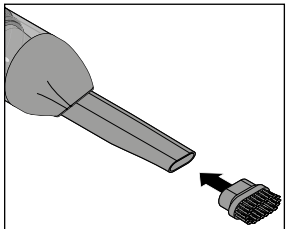
Use the crevice nozzle for all corners, angles and hard-to-reach places that cannot be reached with the normal suction nozzle.



- ▷ Insert the crevice nozzle, wider opening first, into the suction nozzle as far as it will go.

Using the brush attachment

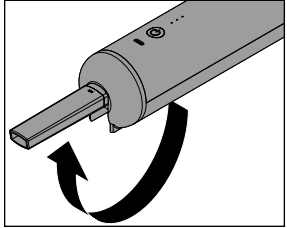
Use the brush attachment for upholstery and for sensitive surfaces.



- ▷ Push the brush attachment onto the crevice nozzle as far as it will go, as shown.

Using the blower nozzle

With the blower nozzle, you can blow dust and dirt out of every little corner.



- ▷ Fold the blower nozzle (on the underside of the appliance) upwards as far as it will go until you hear and feel it click into place.

Cleaning the appliance

Cleaning the brush attachment and crevice nozzle

1. Switch off the appliance and remove the crevice nozzle and, if necessary, the brush attachment from the appliance.
2. Remove hair or other dirt from the brush attachment or crevice nozzle.
3. Wipe the brush attachment and the crevice nozzle with a slightly damp, lint-free cloth.

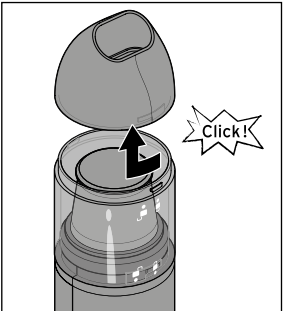
Emptying and cleaning the dust collector

NOTICE - material damage
The appliance must not be switched on when you remove the dust collector.

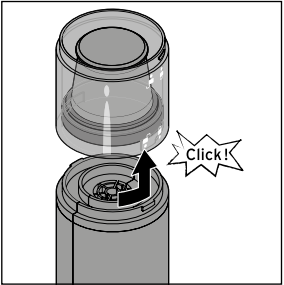
Empty the dust collector regularly to avoid a decrease in suction, overheating of the appliance and excessive dirt in the filter.

1. Switch off the vacuum cleaner.
2. Hold the vacuum cleaner with the dust collector facing downwards.

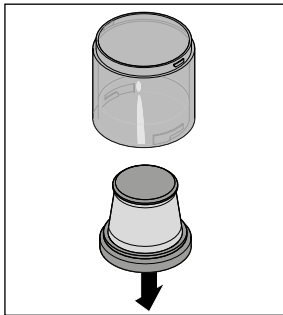
- It is best to remove the dust collector directly over a bin.



3. Turn the suction nozzle clockwise as far as it will go and remove the suction nozzle from the dust collector.

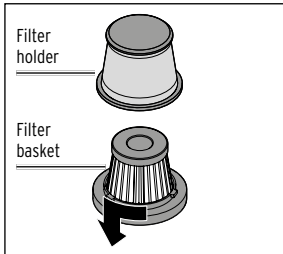


4. Turn the dust collector anti-clockwise as far as it will go and remove the dust collector from the casing.
5. Empty the dust collector.



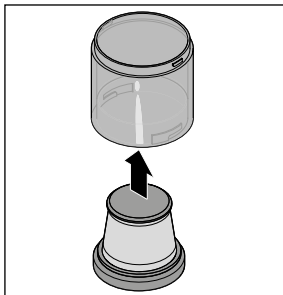
6. Take the filter out of the dust collector.
7. Wipe the dust collector out with a damp cloth if necessary.

Cleaning the filter

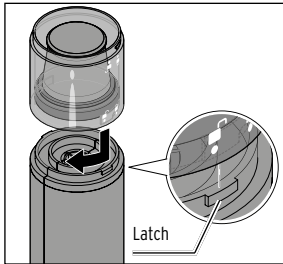


1. Turn the filter basket clockwise as far as it will go and pull the filter basket out of the filter holder.
2. Tap out the filter basket and the filter holder over a waste bin. You can also brush out the filter holder or wipe it down with a damp cloth.
3. Allow the filter basket and filter holder to dry completely before putting them back together in reverse order.

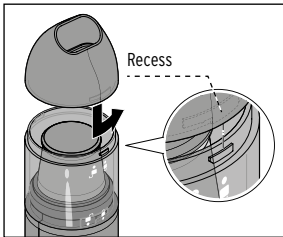
Reassembling the vacuum cleaner



1. Put the filter into the dust collector.



2. Place the dust collector onto the casing so that the latch on the casing points to the symbol on the dust collector. Then turn the dust collector clockwise so that it points to the symbol (see illustration). You must hear and feel the dust collector click into place.



3. Place the suction nozzle onto the casing so that the recess on the inside of the suction nozzle points to the symbol on the dust collector. Then turn the suction nozzle anti-clockwise so that it points to the symbol (see illustration).

Cleaning the casing

NOTICE - material damage
Do not use any caustic, aggressive or abrasive products for cleaning.

- ▷ If necessary, wipe the casing with a slightly damp, lint-free cloth.

Problems / solutions



Not working

- Is the battery charged?

Poor suction

- Is the dust collector full?
- Is the filter very dirty?
- Is the battery sufficiently charged?
- Is the dust collector inserted correctly?
- Is the filter inserted correctly?
- Is the filter dirty?
- Is there something stuck in the suction opening?

Disposal

The product, its packaging and the built-in rechargeable battery have been manufactured from valuable materials that can be recycled. Recycling reduces the amount of refuse and preserves the environment.
